

# Adult Annual Wellness Exam Code List

**Wellness Exam Codes** - are used to report preventive medicine evaluations and management. The extent and focus of the services will largely depend on the age of the patient.

**New Patient – Initial comprehensive preventive medicine** evaluation and management of an individual including age and gender appropriate history, examination, counseling/anticipatory guidance/risk factor reduction interventions, and the ordering of laboratory/diagnostic procedures.

**99385** – 18 – 39 years old

**99386** – 40 – 40 years old

**99387** – 65 years old and older

**Established Patient – Periodic comprehensive preventive medicine** reevaluation and management of an individual including age and gender appropriate history, examination, counseling/anticipatory guidance/risk factor reduction interventions, and the ordering of laboratory/diagnostic procedures.

**99395** – 18 – 39 years old

**99396** – 40 – 64 years old

**99397** – 65 years old and older.

## Other additional codes that can be billed separately with the modifier 25.

**99202-99215** – Evaluation and Management - If in addition to the Wellness visit you meet criteria to bill one of these codes of evaluating and managing a disease. (add modifier 25)

**99401** - Preventive medicine counseling- and/or risk factor reduction intervention – approx. 15 min.

**99402** - Preventive medicine counseling – and/or risk factor reduction intervention - approx. 30 min.

**99403** – Preventive medicine counseling – and/or risk factor reduction intervention - approx. 45 min.

**99406** – Smoking and tobacco use Cessation Counseling intermediate (3-10 minutes)

**99407** – Smoking and tobacco use Cessation Counseling intensive (greater than 10 minutes)

**99408** – Alcohol and/or substance (other than tobacco) abuse structured screening (eg. AUDIT, DAST), and brief intervention (SBI) services 15 to 30 minutes. (Do not bill if less than 15 minutes.)

**99409**– Alcohol and/or substance (other than tobacco) abuse structured screening (eg. AUDIT, DAST), and brief intervention (SBI) services greater than 30 minutes.

**99497** - **Advance** Care Planning (16-45 minutes)

**99498** - Advance Care Planning (At least 46 minutes; to be billed in addition to 99497)

\*Per the CPT book, "a unit of time is attained when the mid-point is passed." (ie. If the time requirement is 30 minutes, a minimum of 16 minutes must be spent; if the time requirement is 15 minutes, a minimum of 8 minutes must be spent... and so on.)
