Universal Criteria Checklist

Applies to all Providers, Vendors and Facilities alike:

- Services PQA patient geographic area (Bannock and/or Bingham Counties)
- Unrestricted License by the State of Idaho
- Accepts Medicare
- In good standing with State and Federal regulatory agencies
- PQA Participating Provider Agreement signed
- Shares licensure and certification information with PQA
- Provides PQA any objective quality data currently tracked for consideration, as well as ongoing data for continual measurement of quality, efficiency and outcomes
- Agrees to cooperate with PQA on quality and clinical integration initiatives
- Does not have a conflict of interest with PQA (Must disclose any potential conflict of interest in the application for consideration)

Service Provider Criteria Checklist

Applies to Ambulance, DME Vendor, Infusion Service Pharmacy, Lab, Mobile Imaging:

- Universal Criteria above met, *plus*
- PQA Business Associate Agreement signed, *plus*

Ambulance Criteria:

- Accredited by Commission on Accreditation of Ambulance Services (CAAS)
- Holds current business agreement with Portneuf Medical Center

Durable Medical Equipment Vendor Criteria:

- Provides same day delivery
- Is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week
- Provides set-up for services like nebulizers
- Provides equipment for patients of all age groups

Infusion Service Pharmacy Criteria:

- Staffed by ACCP Certified Pharmacist or PharmD

Lab and Mobile Imaging Criteria:

- Does recall rate reporting
- Turnaround time:
 - (Lab) 48 hours for non-reference lab work (excludes microbiology)
 - (Mobile Imaging) 48 hours for reports
