Universal Criteria Checklist

Applies to all Providers, Vendors, and Facilities alike:

- Services PQA patient geographic area: Bannock, Bingham, Caribou, Franklin, Oneida, and/or Power County*
- Unrestricted License by the State of Idaho
- Accepts Medicare
- In good standing with State and Federal regulatory agencies
- PQA Participating Provider Agreement and Business Associate Agreement signed
- Agrees to cooperate with PQA on quality and clinical integration initiatives
- Provides PQA objective quality data currently tracked for consideration and ongoing data for continual measurement of quality, efficiency, and outcomes
- Does not have a conflict of interest with Portneuf Medical Center or PQA*

Non-Physician Provider Criteria Checklist

Applies to Chiropractors (DCs), Physical Therapists (PTs), Occupational Therapists (OTs), Speech-Language Pathologists (SLPs), Registered Dietitians (RDs), and Audiologists (AuD)

- Above Universal Criteria met, plus
- Has degree from an accredited professional school
- Holds valid Idaho license as registered professional
- Current professional liability coverage, individually or as a member of a group, through a commercial carrier in the amounts of \$200,000 individual occurrence and \$600,000 annual aggregate
- Chiropractors must be certified by the Idaho Board of Chiropractic Physicians

* Note: If an applicant does not service patients in an established PQA patient geographic area and/or if they disclose any potential conflict of interest they have, the applicant may still be considered for PQA Participation under the following circumstances:

- 1) If services are provided to a rural community that the community would not receive otherwise
- 2) If they provide a specialty service that is not currently part of the PQA Clinically Integrated Network and/or if specialty service is needed for network adequacy
